#### FeralPigScan is a free community resource for monitoring, mapping and



It can be used by landholders, community groups, local government, pest controllers and biosecurity organisations. The FeralScan App is available to download free-of-charge from the AppStore and Google play store. It can be used by anyone to record information about feral pigs anywhere, including areas without mobile reception. You can record sightings and evidence of feral pigs, damage, and control actions. 
Refer to these simple instructions when using the App to record feral pig sightings, damage or control actions. These are available on the Website.

How to record feral pig sightings or activity

#### **Recording feral pig information in 4 simple steps**



From the app home screen select the feral pig image.



Select either the 'Sightings' 'Damage' or 'Control' buttons to begin recording.

The date and location will automatically appear. Answer all relevant questions.

Upload a photo (optional) then select 'Submit'.

4. Submit report



## How to view data from your entire group

If you are part of a Private Group using FeralScan, you can view all the records from members of the Group on the map. Follow the steps below.

- 1. Open the website, and Login
- 2. Open the Map
- 3. Click on 'Select Data'
- 4. Select your group name, and 'View on Map'
