Are Wild Dogs causing problems in your local area?

Record information into WildDogScan to help protect farmers and biodiversity.

WildDogScan is a free community resource for monitoring, mapping and managing wild dogs. People are using WildDogScan to record wild dog activity and coordinate local control programs. It can be used by landholders, community groups, local government, pest controllers and biosecurity organisations. 1. Select wild dog



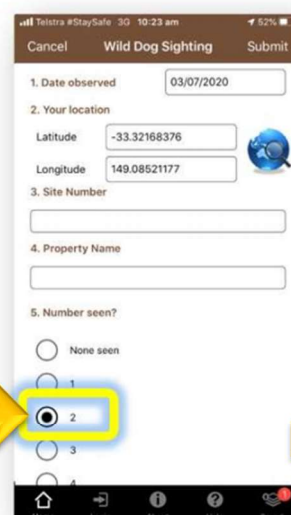
From the app home screen select the wild dog image.

2. Select Sightings



Select the 'Sightings' button to begin recording.

3. Answer the questions



The date and location will automatically appear. Answer all relevant questions.

4. Submit report



Upload a photo (optional) then select 'Submit'.
